

Section 12: Partnerships & Agreements

Potential Partnerships

- In partnership with The City of Ormond Beach and Volusia County apply for the grants identified in the funding section.
- Partner with developers to add more landscaping along their subdivisions.
- Partner with the Chamber of Commerce, the Tourist Development Council and Visit Florida to develop brochures.
- Daytona Beach Community College partnered with the Ormond Beach Scenic Loop to create their Corridor Video and they have committed to creating a video for the combined/expanded Corridor.
- The Save the Loop organization will partner with the CME to sponsor the annual 5K Run.
- The CME can partner with the local garden clubs to add landscaping in the right-of-way.

Following is a list of organizations and government entities we are working with to obtain signed partnership agreements:

- Ormond-by-the-Sea Rotary - will be discussed at their next Board meeting
- Tomoka State Park - documents have been forwarded to Tallahassee by Park Manager. He is waiting for State approval.
- North Peninsula State Park - meeting with Park Manager on 10/8/06 to deliver agreement for his review and signature.
- Florida Power & Light - meeting scheduled for next week with Director of Public Relations
- Ormond Main Street, Inc. - documents provided to Executive Director who will review them and contact us after discussing with her Board.
- Ormond Beach Chamber of Commerce - Executive Director and President are reviewing the documents. Will discuss at their board meeting at end of October. They anticipate approval.
- Rotary Club of Ormond Beach - documents sent to President on 10/3. Have not received response
- City of Ormond Beach - Sr. Planner and her supervisor are working on obtaining approval of the agreement now
- County of Volusia - Joe Jaynes has a signed resolution
